Easter is a very important time in our Church and School calendar, and each year our students celebrate and experience the events of Holy Week through the poignant re-enactment of the Stations of the Cross. Each class selects a Station and is involved in the dramatisation, gospel reading and reflection passage witnessed by staff, students and our many visitors.

The liturgy provides an important opportunity for our students to reflect upon the feelings and actions of Jesus, Mary, the Disciples, Pontius Pilate, the crowd, the two thieves, the soldiers and Simon (who helped Jesus carry the cross), and helps them relate to their own feelings and actions in everyday situations.
